



## Privacy Policy

### 1. Introduction

1.1 When you use our services or visit our websites, you may provide us with information about you. This policy explains what information we collect, why we collect it and what we do with it. It also explains how you can access, update and delete this information. We take your privacy and the security of your information seriously and we encourage you to contact us at [basecamp@summitorbust.org](mailto:basecamp@summitorbust.org) if you have any questions.

1.2 This policy does not apply to our partners, affiliates and linked websites who also collect information. Please check their policies on privacy for further details.

### 2. Information that we collect

2.1 We collect information in three main ways:

2.1.1 **Information that you give us**, such as when you contact us or register for any of our services. For example, your contact and address details. We treat this as personal information. You can access, manage or delete such information that we hold about you by contacting us.

2.1.2 **Information that you publicly share** on our websites or social media sites. For example in blog posts or comments.

2.1.3 **Information that we get from your use of our websites**, such as when you avail of any of our partners' special offers. This includes the use of cookies. This is not treated as personal information as it does not personally identify you. By continuing to browse our sites you are agreeing to our use of cookies.

### **3. How we use the information that we collect**

3.1 We use the information that we collect to provide our services to you. It allows for a better user experience and a more personally tailored service for you.

### **4. What are cookies?**

4.1 A cookie is a text file that is stored on your computer or mobile device by a website's server. It will contain some anonymous information such as a unique identifier, the site name and some digits and numbers. Only that server will be able to read that cookie.

4.2 A cookie allows a website to "remember" you. This could be for the duration of your visit (a "session cookie") or for repeat visits (a "persistent cookie"). Cookies make the interaction between you and the website faster and easier. If a website doesn't use cookies, it will think you are a new visitor every time.

4.3 Cookies may be set by the website you are visiting ("first party cookies") or they may be set by other websites who run content on the page you are viewing ("third party cookies").

### **5. Transparency and choice**

5.1 We want you to be clear about the information that we collect and why we collect it, so that you can make an informed choice about what information you wish to provide.

5.2 If you do not want to share information collected by cookies and other technologies then you can adjust your browser settings. You can also delete cookies that have already been set. However, this may prevent some websites working properly or efficiently.
